June 1st - Beginning of Hurricane Season



June 1st is the start of the hurricane season and NOAA is predicting an above average season of activity this year. They are predicting between 11 and 17 named storms with 5-9 hurricanes and 2-4 major hurricanes with winds above 111mph.

As we are all very familiar with Matthew last year, now is the time to starting preparing your course of action if something similar occurs this year.

Beaufort County Sheriff's Office, in coordination with other governmental and public utility entities serving Beaufort County, has made improvements to public information. In the event of an emergency or natural disaster, they primarily communicate with the public via e-mail and text through their NIXLE alert and advisory system, which links to social media sites: Facebook and Twitter. NIXLE is also the engine they will use to coordinate between governmental and public utility entities in advance of a message being released to the public. Through their website <http://www.bcsso.net/> and ahead of hurricane season, they ask you to please subscribe to their NIXLE alert and advisory system to receive up-to-date information from the Beaufort County Sheriff's Office. In addition, they have added an alert link to their website <http://www.bcsso.net/>, where those who have not subscribed to NIXLE can access the same reliable information as those who have.

In the event of an emergency or natural disaster, please look to your county and

local government officials, along with trusted print, radio and television media as your sources of information and instruction. We urge you to avoid information spread through social media, unless disseminated by one of the trusted sources.

As last year, the Town will provide information in the event of a natural disaster through both its Newsletter and Facebook page.

Also, in today's Beaufort Gazette/Island Packet, it contained the annual Hurricane Guide. It is highly recommended that you get a copy of it. It contains a wealth of valuable information of what to do, before, during and after an event such as a hurricane.

Beginning June 1, the Hurricane Guide will be available at all South Carolina Welcome Centers, at any Walgreen's store statewide and at SCDMV offices in Bamberg, Beaufort, Bluffton, Charleston, Conway, Dillon, Florence, Georgetown, Kingstree, Ladson, Lake City, Little River, Mullins, Moncks Corner, Mount Pleasant, Myrtle Beach, North Charleston, Saint George and Varnville.

This coming Saturday is the first Saturday of the month, so once again it's time to spend an hour and help pick up litter in the old village.

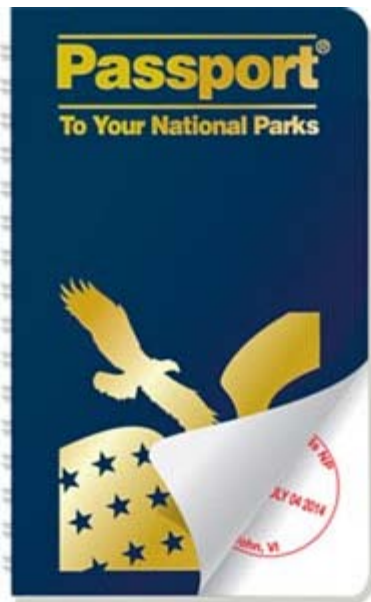
New volunteers are always welcome and encouraged to attend and lend a hand keeping Port Royal clean.

A brief description of the duties are:

E. Powers and Duties. The Zoning Board of Appeals has the following powers and duties:

1. Administrative Appeals. To hear and decide Appeals where it is alleged there is error in an order, requirement, decision, or determination made by an Administrative Official in the enforcement of this Code (see Division 8.5);

2. Variances.

a. To hear and decide requests for Variance from the requirements of this Code when strict application of the provisions of the Ordinance would result in unnecessary hardship (see Section 8.6.20);

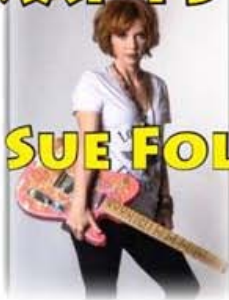

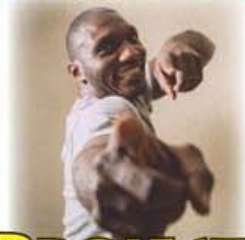
