**Minutes
Council Public Hearing

I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor DeVito called the public hearing to order at 6:31 PM.

II. PURPOSE:

- A. Ordinance 2020-14. An ordinance amending section 6.4.10 nonconforming signs of the Port Royal Zoning Code to allow minor modifications to sign-face attachments (Amendment allowing billboards to be retrofitted with "Hurricane Frames")**

This ordinance is submitted by Adams Outdoor, who has two billboards within the Town. They would like the opportunity to create a hurricane-safe billboard structure, reducing the risk to property and people. The metro planning commission has given a positive recommendation to Council, and other local municipalities have approved this change.

No public comment was made at this time.

- B. Ordinance 2020-16. An Ordinance to amend as follows Section I of Ordinance 2019-9 to provide for the levy of taxes for ordinary Town**

purposes in the Town of Port Royal, South Carolina, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 and to provide for the expenditures thereof. – (Approval of Budget 20/21)

Based on the information received during last the budget workshop, the budget has reduced expenditures and looks to be approximately \$7,200,000 and set at 74 mils.

No public comment was made at this time.

C. Community Development Block Grant – Sewer Expansion

This is Community Development Block Grant to bring sewer expansion to Smilax Rd, Narcissus Lane, and part of Royal Palms Rd. The projected cost is \$858,000, with the Town supplying roughly a \$400,000 match. This would provide sewer to 144 residents.

No public comment was made at this time.

The public hearing adjourned at 6:36 PM.
