

## RECYCLING

Items should be placed in your **GREEN** lid or marked recycling bin; separation of items is not required. **All items should be clean, rinsed and labels removed.**

The following items are accepted:

- Flattened cardboard that fits in cart
- Newspapers, brown bags, magazines, telephone books, paperboard cartons (cereal boxes, snack boxes etc.)
- Steel, tin & aluminum cans, foil casserole pans and pie plates
- Clear, brown, green and blue glass
- Plastic bottles including HDPE containers (dishwashing soap bottles, shampoo bottles, water bottles, milk jugs)
- Mixed residential paper (junk mail, office/notebook paper, writing paper, envelopes, etc.)

The following items are **not** accepted:

- Tires
- Stryofoam
- Aerosol Cans
- Hoses
- Plastic grocery bags
- Pizza boxes

## SOLID WASTE

Each home is provided a 96-gallon garbage cart (**BLUE** lid) All household garbage must be bagged and placed inside the container. Waste Pro will only pick up what is inside of the provided container. Other guidelines are as follows:

- Place your **BLUE** LID 96-gallon garbage cart for collection adjacent to, but not in the street by 6:30 AM on the scheduled pickup day.
- Cart handles and wheels should be facing the home, with cart opening facing the street and should be 3 feet or more from other objects such as cars, mailboxes, trees, etc. Do not place container within 3 feet of objects.
- Recycling containers will not be dumped on garbage service days.
- Hazardous waste will not be collected curbside. For details on disposal of hazardous waste please go to Beaufort County Solid Waste and Disposal website at [www.bcgov.net](http://www.bcgov.net).

## BULK & YARD WASTE COLLECTION

If you have large bulky items, trash that will not fit in your container, or yard waste that needs to be picked up, please call the Town of Port Royal at **843-986-2215**.

Bulk pickups and yard waste pickup are handled through the Town of Port Royal.

## CARTS & CART PLACEMENT

Place your garbage roll carts and recycle roll carts at the edge of the road no later than 6:30 a.m. on the day of collection and remove carts and bins after they are serviced on your collection day.



Be sure your garbage roll carts' wheels are facing the house within 3 feet of the edge of the road.



Leave a 2-foot space between roll carts and a 3-foot space between the roll carts and obstructions like mailboxes, parked cars, utility poles, etc. All garbage must be bagged and fit inside your garbage roll cart with the lid fully closed.

Never block streets, sidewalks, mailboxes or driveways.
