

BORROW-A-TRUCK

TOWN OF PORT ROYAL

DUE TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL'S RECYCLE AND WASTE DISPOSAL LAWS AND THE POLICY AT LANDFILL SITES, THE FOLLOWING MUST BE OBSERVED:

ALL YARD WASTE MUST BE SEPARATED:

Leaves, limbs, grass clippings, vines, roots, and things of such nature may be disposed of together.

APPLIANCES:

Washers, dryers, refrigerators, stoves and furniture must not be mixed with yard waste or building materials.

BUILDING MATERIALS:

Wood from building, sheet rock, bricks and flooring may not be mixed with yard waste or appliances.

TIRES:

Tires may not be placed on the truck.

If items are mixed on the truck, they will be dumped back into the BORROWER'S YARD.

TOXIC WASTE

TOXIC WASTE WILL NOT BE MIXED WITH YARD WASTE, BUILDING MATERIALS OR APPLIANCES.

TOXIC WASTE INCLUDES ANY CHEMICAL, DRY OR LIQUID.

Some examples of LIQUID CHEMICALS are:

Paints	Paint Thinners
Insect Sprays	Fertilizer Sprays
Motor Oils	

Paints will be taken if can is filled with dirt or sawdust to absorb the liquid paint.

Some examples of DRY CHEMICALS are:

Dry Insect Powders	Fertilizers
Dry Chlorine	Asbestos Floor Tiles
Car Batteries	Dry Storage Batteries
